

Meningitis: Frequently Asked Questions

Who is affected?

- All first time college students
- All students transferring to Del Mar College
- Students who have previously attended Del Mar College prior to January 1, 2012 and experienced a break in enrollment for at least one fall or spring term and are seeking readmission

Who is exempt?

- Any student over the age of 21
- Any student who submits a signed affidavit notarized by the Texas Department of Health Services stating that the student declines the vaccination for reasons of conscience, including a religious belief
- Any student who submits a signed affidavit or certificate from a physician that states the vaccination would be injurious to the health of the student

How to provide evidence of the vaccination to Del Mar College Student Enrollment Center:

- Submit a signed official notification from your physician indicating the month, day, and year the vaccination was administered.
- Submit an official immunization record generated from a state or local health authority
- Submit the affidavit for the appropriate exemption category

Registration Information:

- Evidence of the vaccination must be dated during the five years before and at least 10 days before the first day of the classes of the semester in which the student plans to enroll
- Failure to submit the required documentation will result in disenrollment from all classes.
