Viking Kids Camp Course Descriptions

Arts and Crafts	(Grades 3rd-5th Only)
In this course students will explore the world of arts and crafts while using traditional and unusual art mediums. Students will be encouraged to explore their creativity while engaging in several cooperative and individual activities that promote confidence in the art/craft process.	
Cursive Writing	(Grades 3rd-5th Only)
Learn the vanishing art of cursive writing. Students will be introduced to the cursive alphabet, strengthen fine motor skills with fun exercises, craft pieces of art incorporating cursive writing and learn to write their name in cursive.	
Math (Number Sense)	(Grades 3rd-5th Only)
This course is designed to expand students' knowledge of operational and number system concepts. Topics include operations and number systems, two digit multiplication, power of 10, lattice multiplication, base 10 in standard and exponential form, whole numbers, decimals, written numbers in exponential form, written numbers in scientific notation, base 2 with standard and exponential form, count in binary, converting binary and decimal numbers.	
Time Travel Adventures	(Grades 3rd-5th Only)
In this course students will journey through time to expand their knowledge in a variety of different eras, civilizations and places in history through discussions, art projects, group activities and games.	
Creative Arts	(Grades 6th-8th Only)
In this course students will develop new skills and talents while using a variety of art mediums. Students will be encouraged to enhance their creativity while engaging in several cooperative and individual activities that promote confidence in the creative arts process.	
Destination: Algebra	(Grades 6th-8th Only)
Introduction of variables, constants, expressions, and equations. Topics covered include solving equations, inequalities, simplifying expressions, relations and functions, systems of equations and inequalities, understanding order of operations, arithmetic operations with positive and negative numbers, polynomials, factoring, graphing linear equations and inequalities, exponential functions and radicals.	
Geometry	(Grades 6th-8th Only)
This course introduces basic Geometry concepts. Topics include points, lines, segments, rays, planes, prisms, pyramids, angles, perimeter, area, and volume.	
Junior Anatomy	(Grades 6th-8th Only)
In this course students will learn about basic human anatomy. Topics include exploring organ systems, what functions each body part is responsible for, how each body part works, and exploring careers in healthcare professions.	
Exploring Science	(Grades 3rd-8th)
In this course students will explore a variety of science adventures related to chemistry, physics, biology and the environment.	
Reading Enrichment	(Grades 3rd-8th)
This course is designed to provide extra support for students in individualizing their reading, vocabulary, and comprehension skills.	
Speak Spanish	(Grades 3rd-8th)
This course introduces the basic fundamentals of the Spanish Language. Emphasis on basic listening comprehension and speaking skills.

Code Breakers

Calling all future coders, programmers, & designers! Learn the basics of coding languages like HTML, JavaScript, and CSS through a series of web projects and design challenges each day and be on your way to becoming the next tech star! Whether you want to be the next Mark Zuckerberg or the high school student who just made \$1 million dollars for programming in his bedroom, this course has the essentials you need to begin your journey. Projects will be available on a Black Rocket website to share with friends and family. Students will work in pairs or teams for most of the program. Returning students can create more advanced projects that build on previous years.

Make Your First 3D Video Game!

Try this new version of a Black Rocket classic! This class allows you to develop a game concept that goes well beyond the limitations of the traditional 2D game design classes and create an immersive 3D world. Students will learn the physics behind 3D games, explore beginner event scripting, level design, controlling flow of gameplay, and storytelling. Student created games will be available on a password protected Black Rocket website to share with friends and family. Students will work in pairs or teams for most of the program. Returning students can create more advanced projects that build on previous years.

Minecraft® Modders

Use your favorite game to learn the basics of modding and foundations of programming. Learn scripting and logic statements as you create your first mods! Introductory coding will also be taught through a simulated environment inspired by Minecraft. Student projects will be available on a password protected Black Rocket website to share with friends and family. To access their project at home students must own a PC/MAC version of Minecraft. Tablet, phone, and game console versions of Minecraft are not compatible. Students will work in pairs or teams for most of the program. Returning students can create more advanced projects that build on previous years.

LEGO® Video Games

Combine your two favorite activities: LEGOs and Video Games! Students will create their own LEGO characters and adventures in an interactive 2D Video Game. Everyone is welcome in this one of a kind class. At the end of the program, every student will have a finished LEGO Video Game that can be shared with friends and family through a password protected Black Rocket website. Games are only compatible on PC computers; Mac versions can be created after the program for a \$15.00 conversion fee. Students will work in pairs or teams for most of the program. Returning students can create more advanced projects that build on previous years.

Star Wars® Stop Animation

Make your own Star Wars adventure come to life! Bring in your favorite action figures or Star Wars and create a short film with your friends. Whether you want to recreate a scene from Star Wars or design a new world of your own, this class brings your dreams to the screen. Students will need to bring in Star Wars action figures or vehicles from home, but all other equipment provided. Student-created films will be available on a password protected website to share with friends and family. Students will work in pairs or teams for most of the program.

Minecraft® Animators

Bring your favorite Minecraft characters to life in an animated short film! Learn how studios like Pixar and Disney make movies like *Inside Out* and *Frozen* by using techniques like key framing, tweening, texturing, and animating rigged 3D models! Student projects will be available on a password protected Black Rocket website to share with friends and family. You do not need to own a Minecraft account to use the software in this class. Students will work in pairs or teams for most of the program. Returning students can create more advanced projects that build on previous years. Mac users can play their project at home, but will not be able to edit the project without a PC. Returning students can create more advanced projects that build on previous years.

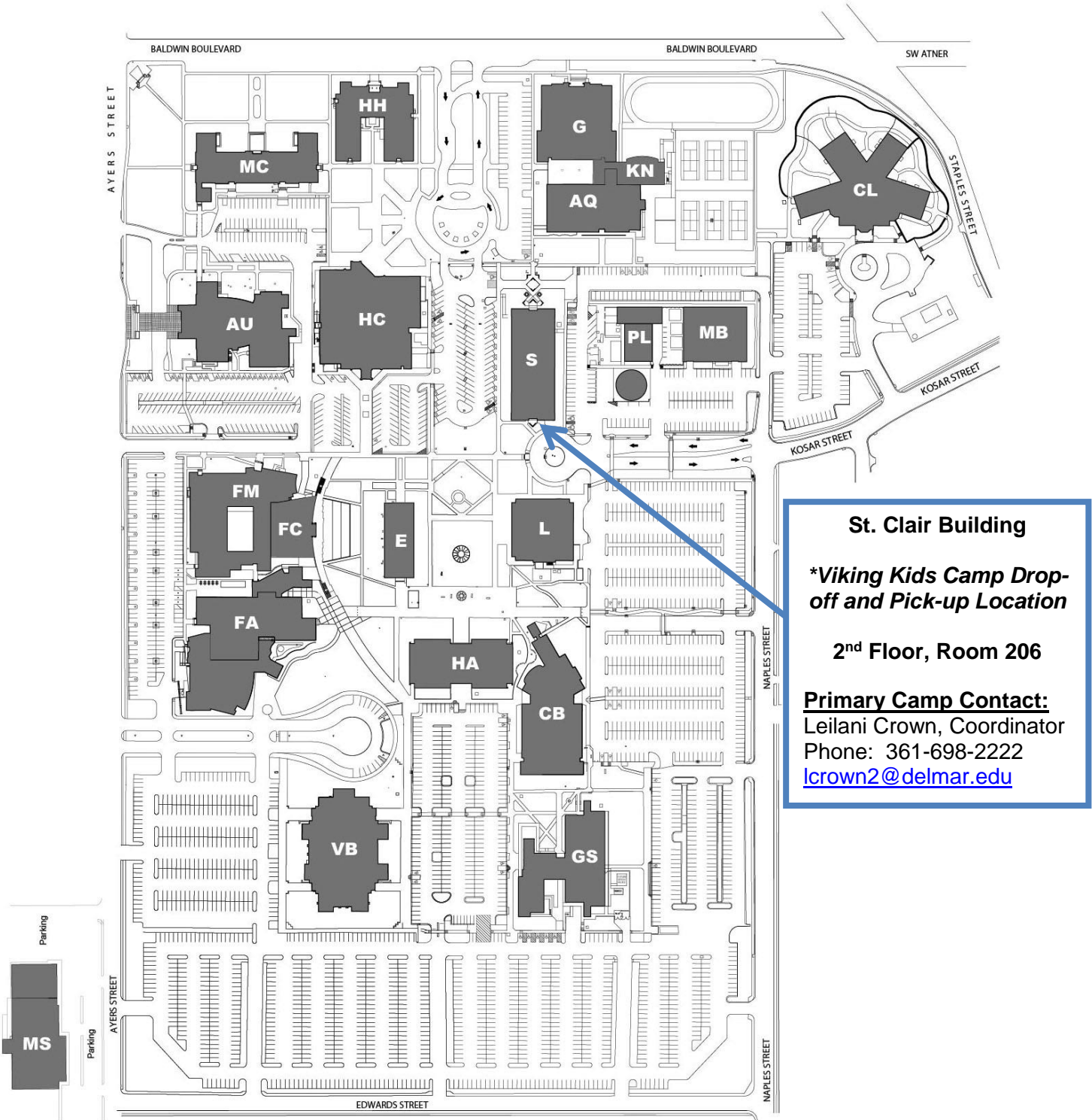

DMC Alert

Introduction

Del Mar College has developed DMC Alert to disseminate critical information in the event of a crisis which may disrupt the normal operation of Del Mar College or threaten the health or safety of members of the Del Mar College community.

DMC Alert is offered on a voluntary self-subscription basis for current faculty, staff, and students at Del Mar College.

DMC Alert delivers messages to subscribers on a "best effort" basis to email and to Short Message Service (SMS) text-capable wireless devices, such as many cellular telephones. Additional delivery options are planned in future phases of the DMC Alert system.

DMC Alert is a personalized service that is designed to complement other tools already used by Del Mar College to communicate with the college community during crises or emergencies. Examples include:
