

Irregular Verbs

What Are Irregular Verbs?

Irregular verbs do not follow any set pattern to form their past tense and past participle.

Ex: The verb **be** has eight forms: am, are, be, being, been, is, was, were.

Commonly Used Irregular Verbs:

Verb be become begin bite blow buy burst catch choose come do (does) drink eat fall feel find forget freeze get give go (goes) grow have (has)	Past was became began bit blew bought burst caught chose came did drank ate fell felt found forgot froze got gave went grew had	Past Participle been become begun bitten blown bought burst caught chosen come done drunk eaten fallen felt found forgotten frozen gotten given gone grown had
go (goes)	went	gone
grow have (has) hide know lay lie	_	-

Verb	Past	Past Participle
make	made	made
rise	rose	risen
run	ran	run
say	said	said
see	saw	seen
show	showed	shown
sink	sank	sunk
take	took	taken
tear	tore	torn
tell	told	told
throw	threw	thrown
wake	woke (waked)	woken (waked)
write	wrote	written
