In this hands-on class, students will learn the basics of first aid, shelter building, foraging and preparing for unexpected challenges. Ignite your inner survivalist and join us for a class of exploration, skill-building, and camaraderie that will leave a lasting imprint on your wild heart!

Frosting Fantasia – Dessert Decorating Unleashed - Indulge your creative sweet tooth in this dessert decorating camp where confection becomes a canvas for delicious artistry! Students will immerse themselves in a world of frosting, fondant, and flavor as they learn the basics of creating edible art. Using different mediums like cakes, cookies, and cupcakes; get ready to let your creativity flow and your taste buds rejoice in this scrumptious adventure!

Submerged in the Tale – Reading Enrichment - This immersive experience is crafted for passionate readers, budding writers, and aspiring public speakers eager to explore the depths of storytelling. Through a captivating blend of reading sessions, creative writing workshops, and public speaking exercises, participants will embark on a literary adventure like no other. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS / COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

What are the age requirements for each camp session?

Students are registered into camp sessions based on the grade they are going into for the Fall 2025 school year.

- If your child is **going into** 1st – 8th grades – they are eligible for the Summer Kids camp sessions.
- If your child is **going into** 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grades, or **has just graduated** 12th grade – they are eligible for the 9th-12th grade camp sessions. This is the only age/grade that is eligible to go into the camp session after they have graduated the said age/grade camp session.

Are scholarships available? Scholarships are dependent on donations. As of March 2025, there are no scholarships available, but you will be made aware if any become available.

Can siblings be in the same camp session if they are different grade levels? For example, can a sister entering fifth grade be in the same camp session as her sibling entering the sixth grade?

Yes! This year we are combining registration for grades 1-8. At the start of each week, we will “group” our registrations based on enrollment and ages. If you would like your camper siblings together – just let us know!

Are snacks provided?

Yes, snacks are provided throughout the day at all our locations for all our camp sessions. Snacks consist of individually wrapped kid friendly items that our staff purchases such as apples / oranges, variety of chips, granola bars, fruits snacks, etc. If your camper has a food allergy, please let us know so we can make appropriate accommodations.

Is lunch provided?

Lunch will be included / provided and will consist of brown bag lunch items. You are welcome to bring a sack lunch or drop off hot lunch for your camper if you prefer.

What if my child cannot attend the whole week?

New this year – we are offering day drop ins! Your child does not have to miss out on a camp experience – Drop in for a day or bundle and stay for two!

Will camp be taking place during the holiday weeks?

There are two holidays that fall during summer kids camp – 6/19 and 7/4. During those weeks we will offer our day SNAP camps. Each day will be a different theme but will follow the same camp day format. Both weeks will offer three days of camp only.

Where can I drop my child off?

Camps are available at two locations this year:

- Center for Economic Development (CED) - 3209 S Staples St CED-109, Corpus Christi, TX 78411
- Del Mar College Oso Creek Campus – 7002 Yorktown Blvd, Corpus Christi, TX 78414 – **Youth Culinary camp location**

Parents are responsible for dropping off and picking up their child to and from the classroom EVERY day. If parent designates another adult to drop off or pick up, that must be arranged the Monday before camp session starts.

What are the prices for Summer Kids camp? See also course schedule details on last page.

- Weeklong camp sessions are **\$250** (This is M-F; 730a-5pm / includes lunch & snacks).
- Snap Camp sessions are **\$75** each day (730a-5pm / includes lunch & snacks)
- Day Drop Ins are **\$75** each day (730a-5pm / includes lunch & snacks).
- Youth Culinary sessions are **\$75** per week (M-F; 4pm-7pm)
- Glam Camp sessions are **\$75** per week (M-F; 1p-4p).

What will my camper's day look like?

This year, we're introducing a new **full-day themed camp experience!** Instead of registering for a single-subject camp (like ukulele or math), campers will rotate through **mini sessions** in **science, art, survival skills, reading/writing, etc.**—all connected to a fun theme.
